

Rules and Regulations

1. A team can have 2 to 3 members.
2. Each and every team is expected to have a Name and a Team Leader.
3. A maximum of 30% plagiarism is permitted in the abstract submission. If more, then the respective team will be eliminated.
4. A team can opt for only one problem statement.

Procedure

The procedure to conduct Vigyaan ensures that only the most excellent, unique and original ideas are selected. It is as follows:

- Problem Statements for each branch are posted . Irrespective of their branch, contestants are free to choose any of the problem statements.
- Round 1: In this round, the contestants have to submit a blueprint or an overview and concept of their project idea in around 200-300 words before the deadline.
- Round 2 will begin after the teams have been narrowed down based on their abstracts presented .
- In Round 2, Contestants will have to present a working model of their project and illustrate it with the help of a PowerPoint presentation. The teams will be judged and the teams that qualify the Round 2 would then display their models at the Vigyaan exhibition.

Timeline

1. **Registration and Abstract Submission:** 15th January
2. **Prototype and Presentation Round:** 30th January (Tentative)
3. **Final Exhibition:** 4th & 5th February
